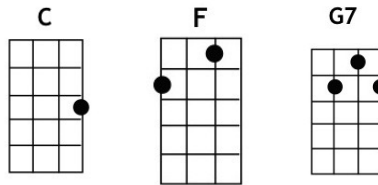


# Oh Susannah
